NOTICE OF FILMING ACTIVITY

May 4, 2021

Dear Neighbor,

Next week, Paramount Worldwide Productions, Inc. will be filming scenes for the feature film “The In Between” on Tybee Island at various locations. The production has applied for all the necessary permits and approvals from the City of Tybee Island and DNR.

- Scenes with dialogue will be filmed at The Crab Shack on the morning of Tuesday, May 12. All crew cars and production will be parked on private property.
- Driving scenes will then be filmed on Battery Drive, a private road on May 12. All crew cars and production will be parked on private property.
- Remaining scenes will be filmed at the Tybee Light Station, Battery Brumby and on North Beach. Filming on North Beach will take place on the beach itself near the Taylor, Gulick and middle crossovers.
 - Prep will take place on Monday, May 10th from 7AM to 7PM. Crews will park at the American Legion. A small portion of the North Beach dirt lot will be used for production vehicles and equipment.
 - Filming will take place on Tuesday, May 11th and Wednesday, May 12th. Limited crew and production vehicles will arrive as early as 4AM each morning to get ready for filming. Filming will take place on Tuesday from approx. 1PM until 10PM and on Wednesday from approx.. 10AM to 12Midnight. Each day, when filming is complete, production crews may still be present until 3AM. Basecamp will be parked at the lighthouse and production trucks will utilize a portion of the North Beach dirt lot. Production catering will use the Shrine Club and the parking directly adjacent to it. Crew will park at the American Legion or other private property.
 - Wrap and cleanup will take place on Thursday May 13th. from 7AM to 7PM. Crews will park at the American Legion. A small portion of the North Beach dirt lot will be used for production vehicles and equipment.

We understand the impact that filming can have on a commercial and residential area, so want to assure you that we are working with the City of Tybee Island to minimize our presence by demonstrating extreme care and consideration. All equipment and trucks will be parked within our area to avoid any unnecessary congestion. We have applied for the necessary permits and maintain all legally required liability insurance.
