Frequently Asked Questions



Did you know the City offers residential yard waste collection?

Yes we do! The City offers residential yard waste collection through Atlantic Waste.

All types of vegetative debris, including: Palm Fronds, branches less than 4-inches in diameter, grass clippings, leaves, and pine straw. Tree trunks larger than 4-inches in diameter will not be picked up.

What type of yard waste does Atlantic Waste collect?



What day(s) does Atlantic Waste collect yard waste?

Yard waste is collected curbside on Wednesdays.

Yes, as long as all the rules are followed.

I have my yard serviced by a contractor. Does the Atlantic Waste collect contractor yard waste?



What is my cost for yard waste services?

\$5.25 per month.

- Branches should be in piles no larger than 5' x 5' x 5', placed perpendicular to the street with the larger end closest to the pavement.
- Paper bags for grass clippings and small debris must weigh under 50 pounds, with a limit of 10 bags per weekly pickup.
- Blue carts for vegetative debris should be placed street-side by Wednesday, with handles facing the house.
- Items like boxes, plastic bags, and loose debris will not be collected and will be tagged by Atlantic Waste.
